Do's and Don'ts:

- Join & contribute to the Neighborhood watch
- If you hear noise near you, please pay attention to see what's going on; If you notice something suspicious, pls call Non-emergency#: 503-629-0111; also, add it to your speed dial; also add it to your kids' phones
- Ensure you have lights on in the front of the house in the night/dark periods; Put a timer for front lights to save energy; You can also get led lights now from homedepot they last for ever and takes less power http://www.amazon.com/15086-Wall-7-Day-Digital-Timer/dp/8002HE070M
- Use wooden rod as door stopper for back sliding doors since the latch is usually not that good and easy to open from outside by jiggling the door.
- Use a deadbolt lock for the front door.
- Get Security system installed; its a deterrent.
- Make Inventory of items at home, photos, videos, etc. Consider using 'safe deposit' box at work.
- Put a lock on your fence doors since burglars often use back doors to make entry.
- Get a Security assessment done for your home; contact Washington County Sheriff Dept @ 503-846-2579 or Darlene Schnoor @ 503-846-277
- Try to get your school-going kids a cell phone, preferably with a Camera. Preferably have them go to a neighbor's house that you trust until you return home.

- 5. Bayonne Av from 127th Avenue to Oxbridge
- 6. Oxbridge Av from Bayonne Av to border of Remington
